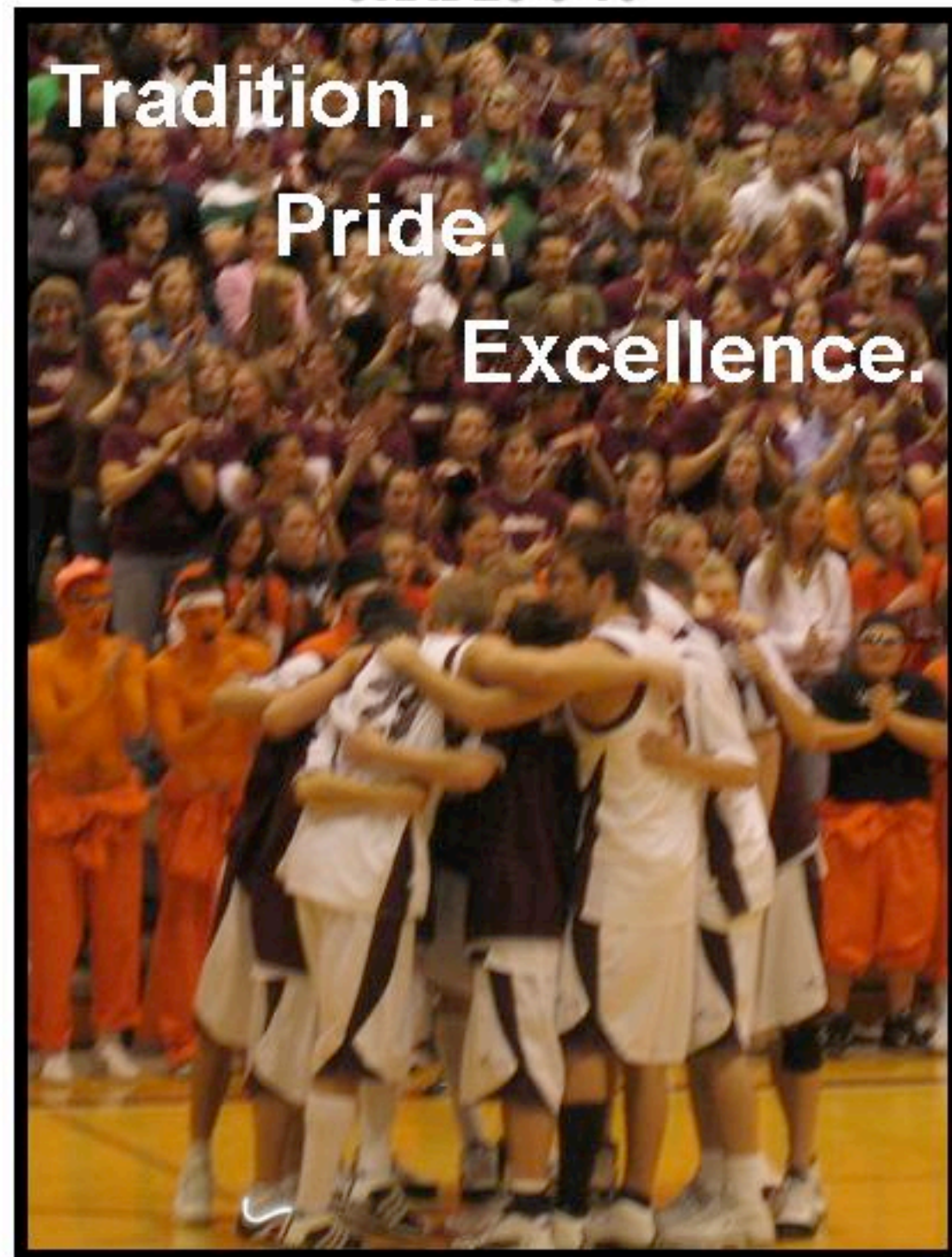

# 2008 Summer Basketball Camps at Seattle Pacific University



During the '07-'08 season, the SPU Falcons earned another trip to the NCAA Western Regional Tournament. This was the 12th time in the past 15 years that the Falcons had qualified for post season play. The Falcons finished up the season with a record of 21-8. Over the past four years, the Falcons, have won more conference games than any other school in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference, winning 49 games.

Two separate weeks of day camp will be held at Royal Brougham Pavilion, SPU's premier athletic facility, on July 7-10 and July 14-17, 2008, as well as a shooting and dribbling clinic June 30-July 2, 2008.

The Falcons' staff has put together an outstanding day camp designed for boys entering third through tenth grades. In addition to daily games and drills, you'll learn:

- Sound fundamentals of offense and defense
- How to develop a self-confident and positive mental attitude
- The importance of team play

# Hoop it up at Falcon Basketball Camps!

## CAMP PURPOSE

Falcon Boys Basketball Camps are designed for elementary, junior high, and senior high boys who want to learn individual and team skills of basketball in a positive environment. Activities include personal instruction by SPU coaches and players, along with opportunities for daily team play.

The Shooting and Dribbling Clinic is designed to improve ball handling skills and shooting skill development.

## CAMP DATES/TIME

Falcon Boys Basketball Camps run Monday through Thursday, July 7-10 and July 14-17. Camp will run from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. with a one-hour lunch break from 12 noon to 1 p.m.

## CLINIC DATES/TIME

The Shooting and Dribbling Clinic runs Monday through Wednesday, June 30-July 2, 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Registration for both camps and the clinic begins each Monday at 8 a.m.

## TUITION/REGISTRATION

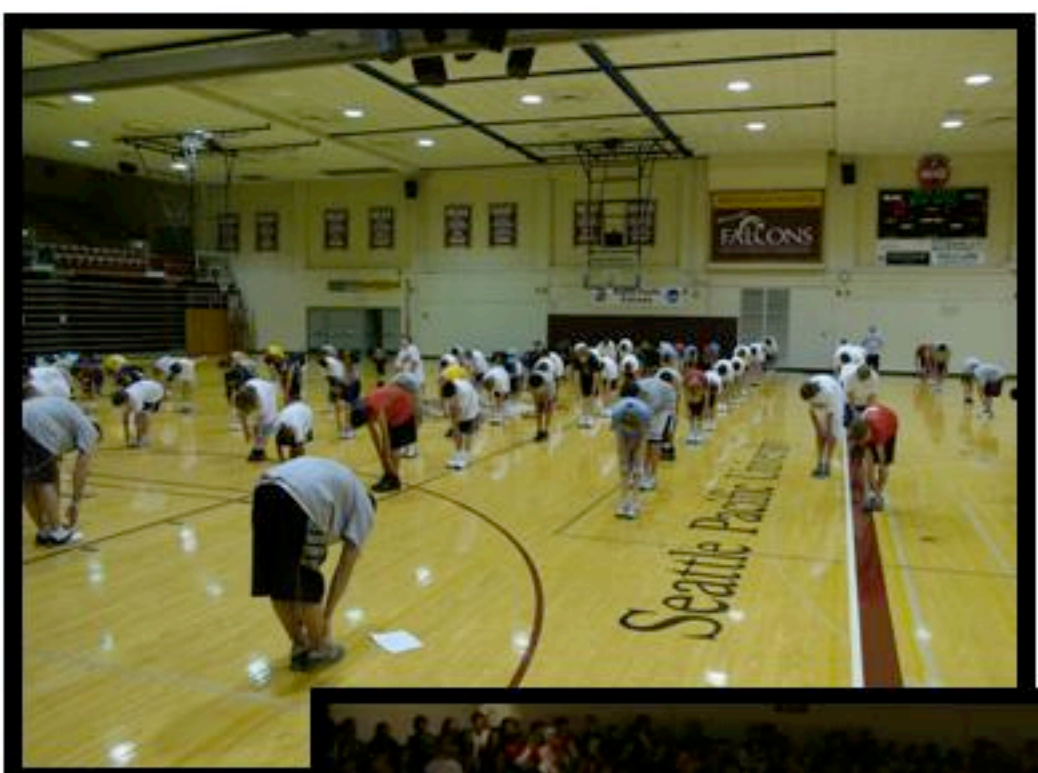
Cost for the week is \$225 (includes Falcon t-shirt and basketball) per athlete. To register, fill out and return the attached form with \$225 tuition for Falcon Basketball Camp or \$115 for the shooting and dribbling clinic (or a \$50 non-refundable deposit with balance due at registration) per athlete to reserve the athlete's spot in camp. The remaining tuition can be paid during the registration hour on Monday, June 30, Monday, July 7 or Monday, July 14. **Make checks payable to Seattle Pacific University.**

## WHAT TO BRING

Campers should bring (or wear) the following: basketball, shoes, sweat socks, gym shorts and t-shirts. **Campers need to provide their own lunch or bring money to purchase lunch each day.** There will also be a camp store that campers can purchase snacks at throughout the week. The store will also provide a bank for campers during the week.

## CAMP STAFF

## FALCON HEAD COACH

Jeff Hironaka is in his sixth year as head coach at Seattle Pacific. Two time GNAC coach of the year and 2006 West Region Coach of the Year, Jeff led the Falcons to the GNAC championship in '06 and '07. He has established Seattle Pacific University as an elite Division II basketball program. To today's date, Hironaka's record as head coach of the Falcons is 115-56.



## FALCON CAMP DIRECTOR

Brock Veltri is in his fourth year as assistant coach and Camp Director for Seattle Pacific. Previously he spent two years in a similar position with Scottsdale Community College in Arizona. He also spent 1 year on the staff at the Idaho State University as a G.A. while completing his master's degree in athletic administration. Coach Veltri has directed and worked a number of basketball camps, including... Phoenix Suns Camp, University of Utah, University Wyoming, University of Richmond, Arizona State and Idaho State to name a few.
